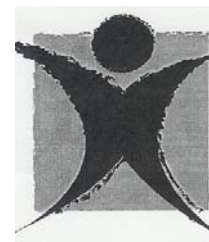

Mission Statement: The mission of the Human Services Coalition of Cayuga County is to bring together human service providers, public and private organizations, and individuals to address the needs of the community through interagency coordination, information sharing and collaboration.

Goals: The Coalition goals are (1) to share information, (2) to promote collaboration, (3) to coordinate services and (4) research community needs.

Services: Information is shared with agencies and the community through *Living in Cayuga County: A Community Directory*, its website, brochures such as HELP Now, benefits charts, a newsletter, emails, grant listings, task groups, linkage to 2-1-1, etc.

Collaboration is encouraged among organizations and within the community through shared information, task groups, community services fairs, training and other activities. The annual Youth Fair and *Our Youth: A Resource Guide for Parents & Adolescents* are projects of the Children & Families Task Group. The Adult & Community Task Group is sponsoring the Community Food Security Project, community services fair, Benefit Chart and other projects. The Elderly & Disabled Task Group completed the *Long Care Needs of Senior Citizens in Cayuga County* in conjunction with NYConnects: Cayuga County LTC Office. Other task groups and collaborations are supported on specific community needs.

Services or programs are coordinated such as the Leadership Matters - professional training workshops, grant listings, the Sharing Your Wishes project, the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and more that benefit many agencies and the community.

Community Needs are determined through data gathered from various sources, aggregated and made available to agencies and the public. Missing pieces of data are identified and if possible, obtained. A collaborative process is encouraged to make decisions on community needs and funding.

Membership: Human services agencies and individuals may join the Coalition for a membership fee ranging from \$40.00 - \$100 for non-profit agencies and \$10.00 for individuals (partial scholarships for individuals are available). For profit organizations may join with an additional \$25.00 fee. Supporting and Sponsoring Organizational memberships are also available.

Coordinating Council: The Coordinating Council is comprised of 15 members elected by the membership of the Coalition. The Council meets monthly, except during July and August. The meetings are always open to the public. The Annual Meeting of the Human Services Coalition is in November when new council members are elected and officers selected.

Task Groups and Collaborations: The task groups meet regularly and are comprised of Coalition members, human service providers and the public. Task groups work collaboratively on a variety of issues and provide a forum for information-sharing. The standing task groups are 1) Adult & Community, 2) Elderly & Disabled and 3) Children & Family. In addition to the task groups, the Coalition collaborates with several groups in the community.

Funding: City of Auburn's Office of Planning & Economic Development (Community Development Block Grant Program), United Way of Cayuga County, foundations, membership fees and grants.
